Papercraft stairs instruction

1. Printing instructions:

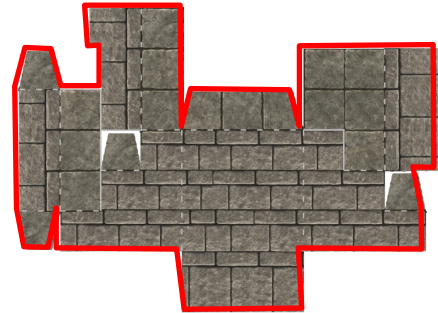
Print on **thick paper** like other accessories. (300g/mm2 recommended)

Only print **one sided**. No need to print on the back because it will not be visible.

2. Cutting and building instructions:

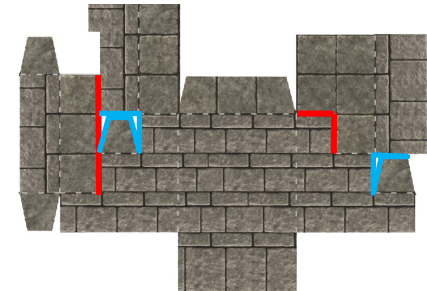
2.2. Cut on the plain white lines (highlighted in red here)

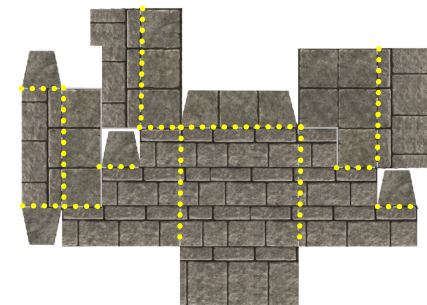
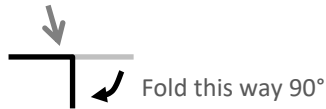


2.4. Fold on each white dotted line (highlighted in yellow here)

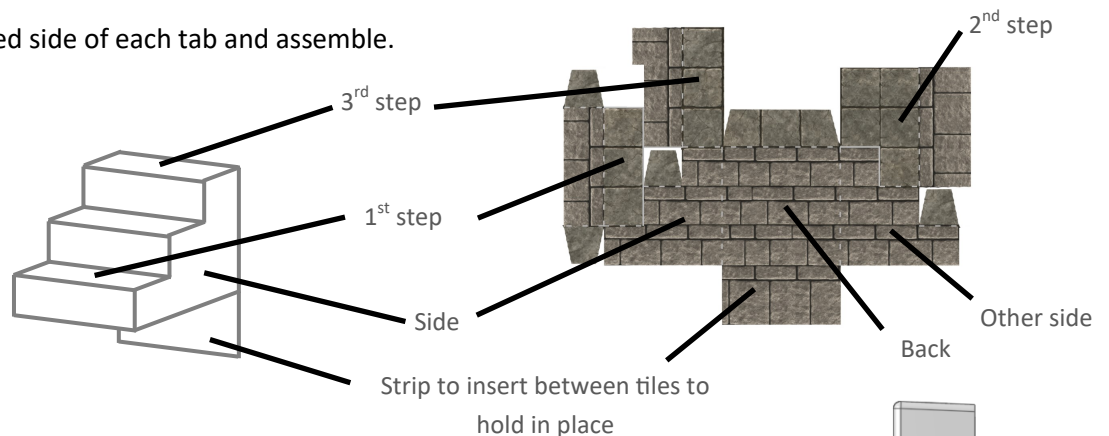
Fold like this: Printed side

There are 13 folds to do in total

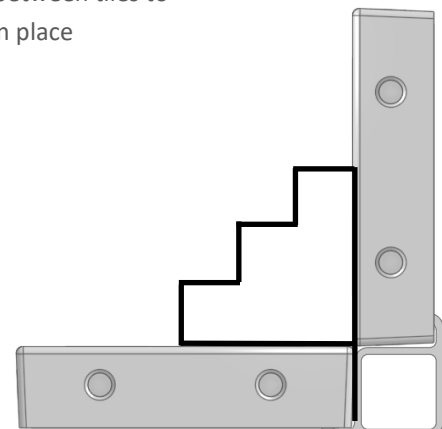


2.5. Put glue on the printed side of each tab and assemble.

If you prefer, you can use sticky tape instead of the glue tabs

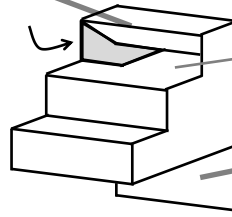
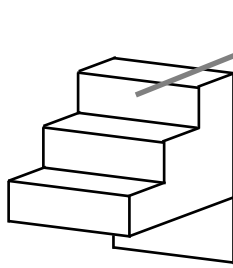


2.6. to make sure the stair is assembled straight, **use a wall and floor tile with the wall clip**. Insert the stairs as in the schematic, and adjust the glueing position. Leave it here while the glue sets.



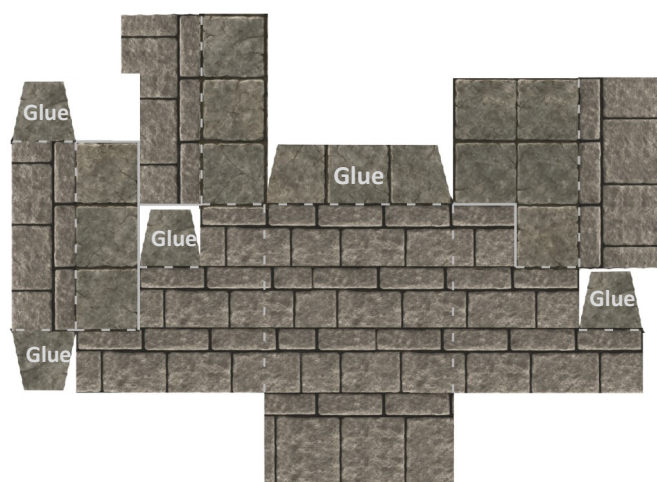
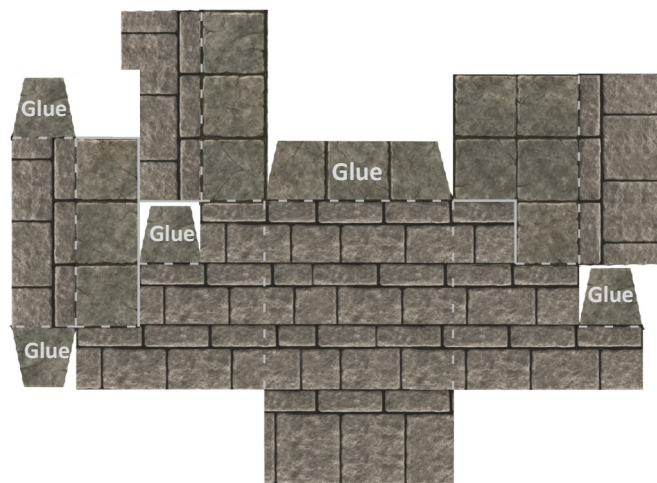
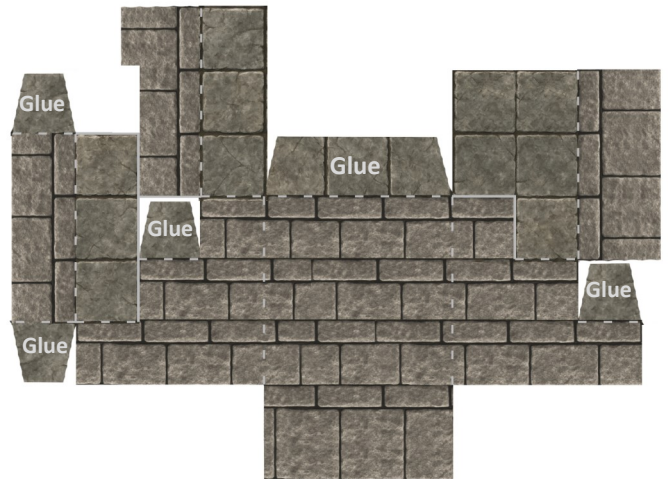
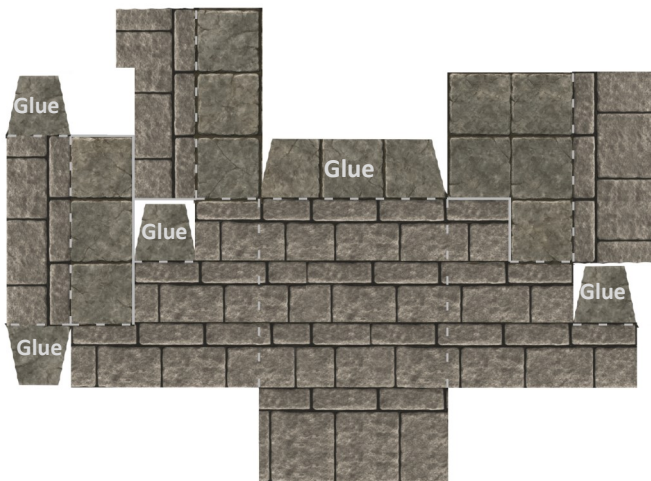
Papercraft stairs: small stone stairs

This wall flips to allow to insert a miniature figurine



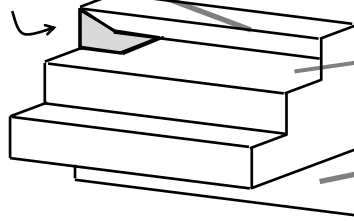
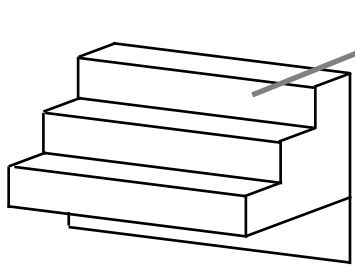
This step has an extension on the back to support the miniature

This wall flips to allow to insert a miniature figurine

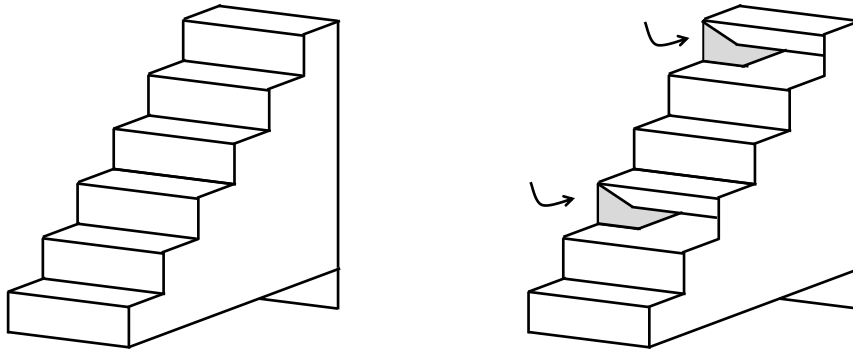
